POLICY DOCUMENT ON INSTITUTIONAL FREESHIPS

“SRI SIVANI UNNATA VIDYA SCHOLARSHIP”

MOTIVE


Sri Sivani College of Engineering under the management of Sri Sivani Educational Society is established in 2006 and it offers B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA Programs. The primary aim of this policy is to provide the financial assistance to the poor and merit students who are not eligible for JVD scheme or any other Scholarship Schemes.

SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and formalize the fee waiver policy in Hostel fee or Bus fee or Tuition fee under the “SRI SIVANI UNNATA VIDYA SCHOLARSHIP” for poor students or merit students for all programs provided by SRI SIVANI COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING under the management of Sri Sivani Educational Society. This scheme will support, orphans, female students, SC, ST students, economically backward students in pursuit of education. It is important to note that this policy does not delineate the admission criteria; such criteria are distinct and are communicated through separate admission notifications for each academic year.

POLICY STATEMENT:

In this program, Rs 5,000/- will be waived for the students in their Hostel fee or Bus fee or in Tuition fee of concerned programmes i.e. including both B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA. The objective of this policy is to alleviate fee to the students who are not eligible for JVD scheme or any other scholarship from other agencies. As an incentive to enrolled students the policy reduces the financial burden by offering them a discount equivalent to the specified amount on their fees. This scholarship based on academic performance, financial need, or specific criteria.

PROCEDURE


Among the enrolled students, a fee waiver is provided to those who do not receive any scholarships through JVD Scheme or any other scholarship from other agencies. Students who from financially weaker section or students those have performed good in their previous examinations shall be eligible for scholarship. The annual income of the parents from all sources should be less Rs. 1,50,000/-

STUDENT ETIQUETTE

The Tuition fee or bus fee or the hostel fee is an exemption applies to the entire Academic year during the duration of their study offered by the college. This benefit is contingent upon the students maintaining good behaviour within both the hostel and college premises, as well as consistently upholding satisfactory attendance records and achieving commendable grades. A student who is benefiting from the tuition fee waiver fail to adhere to the established code of conduct, they will lose their eligibility for the fee waiver for the current semester and any subsequent semesters/years. Instances of such misconduct will be promptly reported to the college's head authority by the hostel in-charges, accompanied by concrete evidence. A comprehensive enquiry will be conducted before any final decisions are reached.

The Management of SSCE reserves the authority to modify or amend the policy and such amendments shall come into force from the date of issue.
